Annex A1 – Logical framework and Activity matrix

The Logical framework (log frame) is a matrix form to be filled with all the information already present in the narrative part of the Application form, adding indicators where possible. It will be the basis for the future reporting and monitoring of the project. The term "results" includes: Overall Objective (impact), Specific Objective (outcome), other outcomes and Outputs.

Outcome (s) (Specific	Specific objectives are concrete statements describing what the project is trying to achieve. The specific objective (s) should be written in clear way so it can be evaluated at the conclusion of the project to see whether it was achieved or not. (It is good practice to have one specific objective only, however, other short term outcomes can be included here)	(see definition above)	Factors outside project management's control that may influence on the impact-outcome(s).
Outputs	The direct/tangible products (infrastructure, goods and services) delivered/generated by the intervention (*Outputs should in principle be linked to corresponding outcomes through clear numbering)	(same as above)	Factors outside project management's control that may influence on the other outcome(s)/output linkage.
